Description of Content: This is a class designed to help you put together a cohesive portfolio of photographs. We will review each person's work, looking for stylistic patterns and preferences. We will write artist statements to help define your overall theme. Once a month you will bring in a revised group of photos and receive feedback on how they work together, and how to fill in any gaps in the portfolio. The goal of the class is to identify your personal style and bring deeper meaning to your work.

Participants should be prepared to bring prints to class for discussion. They do not have to be large or final prints, but since we will be working on sequencing, it is better not to use electronic images.
